Charitable activities 2021

- ✓ "Project Breathe", May July, 2021: Worked together as a consortium led by Bay Area Prabasi (BAP)
- ✓ Raised \$12,000 to help Covid-19 affected in India (out of which \$1470 was raised by Utsav's Youth Volunteers)
- ✓ Additional \$3000 donated directly to BAP by few Utsav members
- ✓ 5K charitable run (October 3 10, 2021) several Utsav members have been participated and donating for the local charities
- ✓ Youth volunteers sold over 50 T-shirts during Sharodotsav and along with matching fund from Utsav has donated \$1000 to Sacramento Food Bank on November 24, 2021

India Day: August 15, 2021

- ✓ Coordination of an online recorded program by Utsav members
- ✓ Participated in a parade in Downtown Sacramento

Sharodotsav 2021:

- ✓ 20th Sharodotsav celebration: October 8th, 9th, and 10th, 2021 at Orangevale Community Center, Orangevale, CA
- ✓ Three days of in-person (with on-line broadcast) prayer, worship, charity, and cultural shows (17 segments) by local talents and cooked Indian food...as always. Totaling over 1800 prasad/dinner/lunch were served to members and friends over this 3-day
- ✓ Published Chowrongee (Utsav's annual magazine) of 116 pages long this edition in commemorating the 20th year

Global Kirtan Event: October 23, 2021

✓ Utsav participated in Global Kirtan Protest in front of the State Capitol organized by ISKON and Sacramento Area friends of Bangladesh to condemn the harsh act of violence and attacks against the Hindus in Bangladesh on October 15th, 2021

India Day: August 20-21, 2022 (Organized by Indian Association of Sacramento)

- ✓ Participated in a parade in Downtown Sacramento
- ✓ Represented as one of the 21 Indian organization in Sacramento Valley

Annual General Meeting (AGM) and Picnic: August 31, 2022 (Today)

- ✓ To update all members/friends with current status and Q&A
- ✓ Over 90 snacks and BBQ lunch for members and friends (to be prepared)

Charitable activities 2022:

- ✓ Utsav Youth Volunteers along with adult guidance have donated \$500 along with some food items to St. John's program on January 8, 2022 in Sacramento
- ✓ Utsav Youth Volunteers participated in a fundraising event (Arts and Crafts Fair) to support St. John's Program for Real Change and the ongoing crisis in Ukraine. It was held on May 14, 2022 at North Natomas Regional Park, Sacramento
- ✓ On June 25, 2022, Utsav Youth Volunteers along with adult members served a five course lunch meal to 70 boarders of St. John's program, which was highly appreciated by the boarders
- ✓ Youth Volunteer has organized a Musical Evening to support Leukemia and Lymphoma Foundation on August 14, 2022 at Folsom City Hall and raised over \$3500

Highlights & Concluding Remarks

Celebrating the 20th year

- Utsav generally organizes four major events annually: Bani Bandana, Bosonto Utsav, Annual General Meeting (AGM) + Picnic, and Sharodotsav. Over 2200 prasad/lunch/dinner has been served during these major events.
- Utsav publishes high quality annual magazine that captures all the community informations and now it's online so digital footprint is established including evolution and history of the Utsav as an organization
- Utsav maintains a website and try to keep up to date with limited volunteering effort (https//www.utsavsac.org)
- Utsav organizes several charitable efforts, e.g., we have raised \$16,000 in 2021 and \$8,500 in 2022 (as of August 2022) as listed above
- Members including youth and kids participate in several cultural programs not only during Utsav's own cultural program but also during other organizations cultural shows (e.g., India day, Anandamela, etc.)
- Utsav members participate in several other fundraising and social activities as some of them mentioned above
- Past couple of years major source of funding comes from members sponsorships and donations (e.g., only before
 and during the 2021 Sharodotsav \$28,000 came from sponsorship of 27 member families and \$17,710 from rest
 of the 72 member families/friends) this is the greatest strength of Utsav, i.e., all of you!!
- This year Utsav will try to raise some funding via advertisement request and you will get that information by next week this will allow current GBM to leave behind some fund for new GBM for 2023-24
- Finally, all the above hard work done by hundred percent volunteering efforts KUDOs to our great volunteers including all the youth volumeters who are working tirelessly to raise fund for great charitable causes A
